the 2015 MAAC Coach of the Year and we're also here to recognize the accomplishments of our young men from the 8th grade Burlington Township Recreation Basketball Team.

At this time, Mayor Carlin calls forward Rider Head Coach Kevin Baggett and reads for the record:

Coach Kevin Baggett is a graduate of Burlington Township High School during his four years Burlington Township School holds the record of 140-13. In his senior year his team finished 31-0 and won the State Group Championship.

During his time at Burlington Township High School as a player Coach Kevin Baggett helped the Falcons win a State Championship; earn three South Jersey Sectional Crowns, and three Burlington County League Championships.

- 1911 career points, 683 points in his senior year alone
- Named to All County Team and was the MVP at the 1985 championship game
- Named BCT Boys Basketball Player of the Year
- Attended St. Joseph's University
- Began his Coaching career leading Cinnaminson High School JV team
- Was an assistant men's basketball coach at Coastal Carolina University, Western Kentucky University, James Madison University, University of Maryland Baltimore County, and Rider University.
- He now begins his fourth year as Head Coach at Rider University.
- He was inducted into South Jersey Hall of Fame in 2006
- And Burlington Township Athletic Hall of Fame in 2011
- In Kevin's third year as Head Coach he tied the program record for 21 season victories.
- Named 2015 MAAC Coach of the Year
- 2014/2015 NABC Division I All-District Coach of the Year
- Was finalist for the 2015 Ben Jobe Award and Joe B. Hall Award
