Empty, non-hazardous aerosol cans are okay! **Don't flatten cans!**

SET RECYCLING OUT BY 6 AM

Metal bar must face the street.

DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO hoses or hangers

NO hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes

NO foil items, bulbs, cookware, or window glass

NO motor oil, batteries, or hazardous items

NO plastic with a



NO Styrofoam

NO plastic envelopes, bags, wrap, or shipping packaging

NO plant pots, trays, lids, cups, or coffee pods

NO shredded paper

• We find hazardous items, like needles and batteries in boxes that residents set out for recycling.

RECYCLING CARTS ARE MUNICIPAL PROPERTY
