**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF BURLINGTON, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AND SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 512 (SOLID WASTE; RECYCLING)**

WHEREAS, Chapter 512 of the Code of the Township of Burlington contains requirements related to the regulation of the collection of garbage and rubbish, to include some types of uncontainerized yard waste; and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP Stormwater Management Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) requires municipalities, through their Municipal Stormwater General Permits, to establish minimum standards for the proper handling, collection and disposal of yard waste as it relates to stormwater management; and

WHEREAS, in connection with a recent audit, the NJDEP has requested clarification to the existing language in Chapter 512;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Burlington, County of Burlington and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. §512-1 is hereby amended to add the following definition: “Yard Waste – includes leaves and garden refuse.”

Section 2. Add new section §512-5(G) entitled “Stormwater Management Provisions.”, which states: “Sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street is only allowed during the seven (7) days prior to a scheduled and announced collection, and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street at any other time or in any other manner is a violation of this ordinance. If such


placement of yard waste occurs, the party responsible for placement of the yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance.”

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions hereof, are hereby repealed insofar as said inconsistency exists.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publications required by law.

This Ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council in the Township of Burlington held on August 25, 2020, and will be considered for final passage after a public hearing held at a regular meeting of the Township Council to be held on September 8, 2020, at the Township Municipal Building, Burlington Township, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m.


