

Important Information about your Drinking Water (September 2023 Update):

As required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), we are providing this update. The test result received for samples collected on August 15, 2023 for PFOA at the Beverly Road Water Treatment Plant was 0.016 parts per billion (ppb). The current running annual average (RAA) for PFOA based on samples collected over the last year is 0.013 ppb which is less than the PFOA MCL of 0.014 ppb.

At this time bids for the Beverly Road Water Treatment Plant Upgrades for PFAS Treatment will be received by the Township on September 20, 2023.
