Important Bulk Waste & Disposal Guidelines

Reminder for Burlington Township Residents: Bulk, metal, and wood collection **CANNOT** be used for:

- ✗ Demolition projects, large construction debris, decks, sheds, fences, or other major projects.
 - ✗ Excess household trash (bags of trash should NOT be placed with bulk pickup)
- How to Dispose of Large Waste Properly:**
- ★ Use the Burlington County Landfill (22000 Burlington-Columbus Road).
 - ★ Hire a private dumpster company (permits for street placement available via the Police Department).
 - ★ Work with your contractor to dispose of debris.
 - ▲ Plan ahead for home projects, remodels, or moves! Let's keep Burlington Township clean and organized.

Burlington Township's curbside Spring Loose Leaf Collection is scheduled between March 24, 2025 – May 5, 2025. Leaves in bags or containers cannot be collected but can be taken to the Compost/Recycling Facility. Loose leaves, no branches or twigs, must be placed at the curb.



Tree branch collection will be broken down into sections according to trash routes. Branches must be placed to the curb prior to the starting date in your section since the truck will only go through each street one time. Mattresses and box springs can go out with Bulk Collection only if wrapped in plastic. An appointment is required by calling the Public Works Office at 609- 239-5909, before placing it at the curb. These items can also be taken to the Compost/Recycling Facility, and do not have to be in plastic.



Heavy Pickup – For items such as refrigerators, wood furniture, air conditioners and other large appliances (wood, metal, or plastic items included) or anything that does not fit inside your trash cart. An appointment is required by calling the Public Works Office at 609-239-5909, before placing it at the curb. Computers and TV's must go to the Compost Facility.



All trash must be placed in Burlington Township Hot Stamped Carts. If you have a one-time overflow of trash, please hold it until your next regular collection day or drop off at Compost/Recycling Facility, during normal business hours. We recommend homeowners place a house number decal on their cart for identity.
